

# *More information about Joining*

The Lodge is pleased to consider Joining applications from relevantly qualified serving or Past Masters. The usual approach followed is that you visit the Lodge, at the invitation of one of its existing members and then decide whether or not you would like to join it. If you do, and having established that the member would like to propose you, and that a seconder is available, the Secretary will send a Joining Pack to you for completion.

## *The content of the Joining Pack:*

This will first comprise our Livery Company form, which you must be able to complete. Also you will be provided with a Form M and Data Protection Notice, the former of which also needs section A, front page, completed, signed and dated by you and then short section B on the third page completed, signed and dated by your proposers.

Please read (and keep) the Data Protection Notice : whilst your consent to processing and retention of data is implicit in your signature on the Form M, the Notice's section II is for information and its section III will guide you on ticking the boxes at the base of Form M, page 1. You will need to tick the boxes, or one of them.

Please then obtain all necessary clearance certificates from the Lodges you have listed on Form M, page 1. Do not forget that this must include all Lodges, whether or not you are a still a member. Please note that under BoC Rule 191D any clearance certificates should be in paper form and signed by the relevant Secretary or Treasurer.

When you have assembled everything, please return the complete pack to the Secretary, unfolded. We very much look forward to receiving your completed forms and certificates in due course, and afterwards to welcoming you into this Lodge.



## *Venue*

The Lodge meets and dines in The Guildhall, London. Its meeting days are the first Tuesdays of February and October, and the second Wednesday of May (except in 2020 when it will take place on 6th May 2020).



## *Fees*

Finally, you should note that the Joining fee for the Lodge is £50, the annual Subscription is £120 and our meals currently cost £68 each.
